Hotel: Ibis Styles Yongsan/Fraser Place Namdaemun/Stanford Hotel Seoul or similar

After breakfast, visit the Imperial Palace of the Joseon Dynasty -Gyeongbokgung Palace, National Museum of Folklore. Then, go to Bukchon Hanok Village. It is a well -preserved 600-year-old Korean traditional residential area in Seoul. The village is best known for its eight views of Bukchon. Next, transfer to Ewha Mural Village, a modest neighborhood decorated with public art murals. Afterwards, visit National Museum of Korea here houses a vast collection of over 420,000 artifacts from ancient times to the modern era in a wide range of topics, including art and culture have a photo stop at the N Seoul tower. Later on, watch the amazing The Painters Show. Dinner is on your own arrangement.

After the breakfast, visit the War Memorial of Korea, exhibits and preserves materials related to the Korean War. Then, proceed to Leeum, Samsung Museum of Art, exhibits traditional and modern art works. Next, enjoy your time in Insa-dong with alleys of galleries, restaurants, teahouses, and cafes. Later on, visit the Hwaseong Fortress, a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage Site. It is alternately recorded as being the royal fortress of King Onjo of the Baekje Kingdom. Enjoy the vibrant traditional Gwangjang Market. Enjoy yourself in Cheonggyecheon Area and the famous shopping center Myeongdong. Dinner is on your own arrangement.
