

Luang Prabang (Laos) 3 Days / 2 Nights Land Tours

Luang Prabang is a beautiful and tranquil dream-like setting with a fusion of foreign influences and splendid landscape scenery, making this an idyllic, unspoiled and charming destination for visitors. It is no wonder this amazing city was recently declared a World Heritage City by UNESCO. The ancient city was the former capital of Laos, with a reign of more than 63 kings over 600 years. Luang Prabang is known as the 'Thousand Pagoda City', there are countless intriguing architectural highlights in the sleepy and once royal capital.

Day 1: Arrival Luang Prabang (B)

As you will arrive in our heritage town, you will be picked up and transferred to your centrally-located hotel. After a short rest, we'll start the visit of the **National Museum**, which presents various leaders and fighters of Laos history, from the ancient times till the new revolution period. Following the Museum, we'll enjoy a sightseeing tour of two magnificent temples: the **Wat Visoun** and **Wat Xiengthong** which is the City's oldest temple, one of the best examples of Luang Prabang's classical architecture. We'll then climb up the **Phousi Mountain** to enjoy its sacred stupa as well as a beautiful sunset view of the city and the river. From there, we'll explore the **Night Market Street**, where you'll be able to find lovely handicrafts made by our local people. Overnight in Luang Prabang

Day 2: Luang Prabang – Pak Ou Cave-Kuang Si Waterfall (B, L, D)

After breakfast we'll take a boat to the mysterious **Pak Ou Cave** and its thousand Buddha statues of various shapes and sizes. Along the way, we'll stop at **Ban Xanghai**, the well-known village for Lao traditional rice whisky to be distilled and tasted. **Return to Luang Prabang by late afternoon and stop at Ban Xangkhong**, a weaving village. After the Cave have Lunch in one of Luang Prabang's favourite restaurants, followed by a long drive to the **Kuangsi Waterfall** with its green surroundings as the preserved National Nature. En route, stop to visit Ban Na Oune, a small Hmong village and also visit **Ban Tha Pane**, a small village of Khmu minority group.. We'll end our day observing Buddhas footprints at **Wat Phabath**. Overnight in Luang Prabang

Day 3: Luang Prabang - Departure (B)

Early morning see a procession of monks. We'll then head to the **Morning market**, the best place to buy presents for your friends and relatives. After breakfast, you will have free time for your own exploration of the town before your transfer to the airport.
