1 Point of Origin – Saigon
Arrive Saigon. Transfer you to hotel.
Overnight at Saigon.

2 Saigon – Mekong – Saigon (B,L,D)
After Breakfast, transfer to visit Mytho, boat trip to visit Flooding Mekong Delta, rowing boat along the Tien River in the shade of green cootree on the sides. Viewing the daily life of the inhabitants working and living on the river. Visit the Bentre Coconut candy workshop, continue to float along the An Khanh canal to visit the honey bee farm. Enjoy the tasteful honey tea and Tai Tu folk music. Proceed to Phung Island,. Short walking to visit handy craft workshop with many products made from coco tree. Visit Thanh Dia Dao Dua (Coco Holyland), a fantastic



architecture structure in Ben Tre. Back to Saigon. Visit War Museum and Reunification Hall which was built in 1865 on the grounds of Norodom Palace as a residence for the French Governor General of Cochinchina. Our next stops are Thien Hau pagoda and China town, continuing to visit City Hall, Ho Chi Minh Monument, Central Post Office and Notre Dame Cathedral, a magnificent building located in the heart of the city, and was built in a French style. Overnight at Saigon

3 Saigon – Vungtau – Saigon (B,L,D)
Transfer to Vung Tau, visit Sakayamuni (Buddha Shane), Niravana Temple, Whale Temple, White Palace. Lunch at restaurant and visit the Baodai villa. Free for relaxing on the beach. Back to Saigon. Dinner
Overnight at Saigon.

4 Saigon – Point of Origin (B)
After breakfast free for the rest till transfer to the airport.
