### DAY 1 Arrive in Chiang Mai

Hotel: Lotus Pang Suan Kaew Hotel or The Empress Hotel or similar

Upon arrival in Chiang Mai, Thailand, a guide will meet you at the arrival lobby and transfer you to the hotel. Free pick-up service is available for flights arrive from 09:00am to 22:00pm. The rest of the day is free at leisure. No meals are arranged today.

### DAY 2 Chiang Mai

Hotel: Lotus Pang Suan Kaew Hotel or The Empress Hotel or similar

After breakfast, proceed to the Maetaeng Elephant Camp, where you can have an up-close experience with the elephant. Ride an elephant with a tropical view and enjoy activities such as painting show from the elephant, bamboo rafting, ox cart rides, get to learn Thailand's rural way of life, and more. Enjoy the buffet lunch at the elephant camp. Afterward, visit the Kayan tribe. People who live here are known for wearing neck rings for years to lengthen their necks until they get married. Later on, visit Wat Ban Den. It is so called - Blue Temple, which is named due to the color of the main structure. Last stop, head to Elephant Poopoo Paper Park. This park creates a paper by the poo from elephants, in order to maintain and keep a good eco-friendly environment. After, DIY a bookmark at the park. Today's dinner is arranged on own. (B/L)

This morning, head out for a tour of Chiang Mai. Drive up the serpentine road to the magnificently situated Wat Doi Suthep. Perched on a forested mountain, this most sacred Chiang Mai Temple provides a superb view over the city, as well as a wealth of images and frescos. Then visit the summer palace of the royal family of Thailand- Pu Ping Palace. A royal winter palace where the Thai royal comes to enjoy the nice weather that Chiang Mai got to offer during the winter. As it located in the mountain and is in the north region, the weather is incredibly nice compared to Bangkok or in a town. You will be surrounded by beautiful flowers and gardens that will make your day better from the smell. However, it is important to remember no shorts or any reveal clothes at the palace. Enjoy the Empress/Dongtan buffet for lunch. Afterward, take a ride on Tuk Tuk, the traditional public transportation in Thailand. While on the ride, you can enjoy the beautiful view of the city. Tour the night market in Chiang Mai. Along the road, there are many vendors selling fruits, snacks and art crafts. Return to the hotel afterward. Today's dinner is arranged on own. (B/L)

**Halong Bay – Ha Noi**

Today, we are going to take a cruise to tour the world heritage, Ha Long Bay, and the other islands around. Ha Long Bay is known for its emerald waters and thousands of towering limestone islands topped by rainforests. On the cruise, enjoy the beautiful scenery and lunch. You can also purchase the fresh seafood from the fishermen on your own expense. After lunch, return to Ha Noi. The first stop back to Hanoi is Hoan Kiem Lake. This lake located in the central of Hanoi. The lake is a freshwater lake. Calm and pretty. Later, proceed to the Old Quarter in Hanoi. This quarter used to be the residential, manufacturing and commercial center. Guests are welcome to shop around and tour. Before the dinner, visit the Ngoc Son Temple, which was built in 19-century.

Upon the arrival of Son Tra Peninsula, we visit the temple, Linh Ung Pagoda, where it can overlook the bay of Da Nang, East Sea and Marble Mountain. Later, visit Cam Kim Island, which is known for its traditional crafts and lifestyle. Taste the seafood meal for lunch. After lunch, visit Hoi An, a well-preserved Ancient Town, in Vietnam. This ancient city is noted since 1999 as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Tourists can fully experience the city by strolling along the streets and tasting the Vietnamese snacks. After breakfast, visit the Thien Hau Temple, which is dedicated to the Chinese Sea Goddess, Mazu. Later proceed to Mekong River Delta for My tho. Upon arrival, take a boat ride on Mekong River. Then, tour the Thoi Son Island. Taste the seasonal fruits on the island, enjoy the dance show and the Orchard. You can also take the canoe to experience the beauty of Vietnam. Today, enjoy the local meal, Mytho Elephant Ear Fish. After lunch, proceed to visit Vinh Tr à ng Temple. It is one of the best-known temples in the region. In the afternoon, return to Ho Chi Minh City for a half-day tour. Highlights include the Reunification Palace, the Municipal Theatre, the Central Post Office and the city hall. (B/L/D)
