Day 01: Home City → Sydney

Day 03: Sydney Arrival

Day 04: Sydney City One Day Tour

Day 05: Blue Mountain Tour

Day 08: Gold Coast – Brisbane – Melbourne

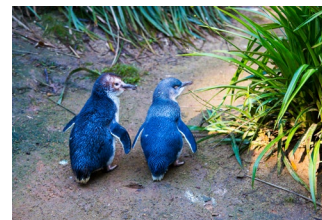
