### Day 1 ARRIVE IN ISTANBUL(IST)

Hotel: DoubleTree by Hilton Istanbul Esentepe or similar

Arrival at Istanbul International Airport, pick up and transfer to the hotel with our receptionist's assistance. The hotel check-in time is after 2pm.

### Day 2 ISTANBUL (B,L)

Hotel: DoubleTree by Hilton Istanbul Esentepe or similar

After breakfast, visit the Sultan Ahmet Camii, which is definitely a must-see regardless of how much time you have in the city. Next, you will visit one of Istanbul's most renowned structures, the Hagia Sophia Grand Mosque. Just down the road from the Blue Mosque is the Basilica Cistern (including ticket, \$9/pp), a "sunken palace" that lies beneath the surface of Istanbul's streets. A stay in Istanbul is not complete without a traditional and unforgettable boat excursion up the Bosphorus (including boat ticket, \$4/pp). Afterwards, enjoy shopping time in Istiklal Caddesi. Dinner is your own arrangement.

### Day 3 ISTANBUL (B)

Hotel: DoubleTree by Hilton Istanbul Esentepe or similar

Free leisure day in Istanbul. Grand Bazaar is recommended for your own visit. It is the historic center of shopping and commerce in the city. You can also visit the the Sulaymaniye Mosque, a masterpiece of Mimar Sinan or Mimar Koca Sinan.

### Day 4 ISTANBUL/ DUBAI (B,L)

Hotel: DoubleTree by Hilton Dubai M Square Hotel & Residences or similar

After breakfast, have a PCR test (the expenses need be paid extra). After lunch, visit Topkapi Palace (including ticket, \$12/pp), which is particularly important for the Chamber of Holy Relics where Blessed Mantle and Holy Banner

are kept in their golden chests. At last, transfer to the airport and fly to Dubai. Upon arrival at Dubai, transfer to the hotel with our receptionist's assistance. The hotel check-in time is after 3pm.

### Day 5 DUBAI-ABU DHABI-DUBAI (B,L,D)

Hotel: DoubleTree by Hilton Dubai M Square Hotel & Residences or similar

After breakfast, transfer to Abu Dhabi, and visit the Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque. The mosque holds a Guinness World Record for the largest hand-woven carpet and also boasts one of the largest chandeliers in a mosque. Then, have a photostop at Emirates Palace from the outside. Afterwards, visit the Louvre Abu Dhabi (including ticket, \$18/pp) which is the Arab world's first museum. The incredible structure of the museum was inspired by the region's rich architectural traditions and unique location. Later on, proceed to Qasr Al Watan (including ticket, \$20/pp), a working Presidential palace and a majestic cultural landmark. Transfer back to Dubai after Abu Dhabi's visit.

### Day 6 DUBAI (B,L)

Hotel: DoubleTree by Hilton Dubai M Square Hotel & Residences or similar

After breakfast, observe the Burj Al Arab Hotel (Sailboat Hotel) outside, which is one of the most famous landmarks in Dubai. Then, take the Monorail to overlook the Palm Island (including one-way ticket, \$8/pp). Viewed from above, the manmade island resembles a stylized palm tree, which was built from reclaimed land mass and a series of artificial archipelagos. Afterwards, go to the world's tallest building, the Burj Khalifa, and enjoy the wonderful view on the viewing platform 'At The Top' (including ticket of Non-prime hours, \$42/pp). Later on, enjoy shopping time in Dubai Mall and observe the Indoor Aquarium. Today's dinner please arrange on your own.

### Day 7 DUBAI (B)

Hotel: DoubleTree by Hilton Dubai M Square Hotel & Residences or similar

After the breakfast, free day at leisure in Dubai or take part in optional tour.

March: Expo Dubai 2020 (including one-day ticket+transfer): \$190/pp.

From April to December: Desert Safari: \$80/pp.

### Day 8 LEAVE DUBAI (B)

After breakfast, transfer to the airport and return to your home.

If you leave Dubai with a night flight, you can choose to take part in the optional tour of the traditional parts in Dubai: \$160/pp. First, visit the Dubai Museum (Travelers who arrive on Monday visit Al Fahidi Historical District instead). It is the oldest existing building in the city and a must-visit for a taste of old Dubai. Then, visit the traditional markets: Gold Souk and Spice Souk. Then, take the traditional water taxi -Abrams across Creek Bay to admire the ancient merchants' houses and modern buildings on both sides of the river. Afterwards, transfer to the airport, you can also enjoy your time in Dubai Duty Free there if time allows.
